Our Recommendation

With consensus from the Facilities Steering Committee, it is our recommendation that the Board of Trustees considers calling a bond election for \$125,000,000 million.

The bond funds would be used to address student capacity issues at the the elementary school, convert the intermediate school to an elementary school (which will complete the district's grade re-alignment plan), and to improve our high school athletic spaces by adding a competition gym and renovating the baseball & softball fields.



New Ballot Language Requirement

House Bill 3 added this requirement for school bond elections, regardless of the impact on the ISD's tax rate:

SECTION 1.008. Section 45.003, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsections (b-1) and (d-1) and amending Subsections (d) and (f) to read as follows:

(b-1) The ballot proposition under Subsection (b) must include the following statement: "THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE."

Separate Proposition Requirements

Senate Bill 30 requires separate propositions for the following:

- Stadium with seating for more than 1,000
- Natatorium
- Recreational facility other than a gym, playground or play area (baseball, softball, etc.)
- Performing Arts Facility
- Housing for teachers
- Technology equipment other than security or infrastructure
